Description

A BPMN Business Data Description table is designed to display or edit class descriptions in a table form. You can display existing classes or create new classes in this table.

Example

| # | △ Name | Documentation |
|---|---|---|
| 1 |  Agreement | Agreement is signed between attendee and Training Center. All details (duration, time, place etc.) about training/consultation is described in agreement. |
| 2 |  Attendee | Attendee is a person who is participating in a training event. |
| 3 |  Attendee Request | Request form filled by attendee for training/consultation |
| 4 |  Dedicated Training / Consultation | Dedicated trainings/consultations are provided for a companies. Consultations may include training classes, best practice sessions, model reviews, and design sessions. |
| 5 |  Feedback Form | Attendee leave feedback about training/consultation. Also attendee evaluates trainer. Future training programs can be modified according to collected feedback. |
| 6 |  Invoice | Invoice can be sent for participating in open training class or for dedicated training/consultation. All invoices are managed by accounting department. |
| 7 |  Open Enrollment | Open Enrollment classes are performed regularly in different locations. |
| 8 |  Training Event | There are two types of Training Events: Consultation and Open Enrollment. Each Training Event should have a Start Date and Duration defined. |
