



# Working with Services Constraints table

The **Service Constraints** (Sv-Ct) table specifies constraints applying to the implementation of Services, as well as constraints governing the use of one or more Services.

To create a Services Constraints table by adding a new Service Policy or Service Contract

1. Click the **Add New** button and choose either Service Policy or Service Contract. The new row is added.
2. In the **Applies To** cell, click  and
  - a. for the Service Policy, in the **Select Service** dialog, select constrained Services.
  - b. for the Service Contract, in the **Select Operational Connector** dialog, select Operational Connector.
3. Click **OK**.
4. In the **Rule Specification** cell, click  and in the **Specification** dialog, select the language and specify body.



The Rule Specification can be defined in English as well as using expressions or formulas (OCL).

5. Select the **Rule Kind** from one of the following:
  - Structural Assertion
  - Action Assertion
  - Derivation
  - Contract
  - Constraint
  - Guidance
  - Security Policy
  - Caveat



Additional constrained elements can be added and edited for every row in the table.

To add an existing Service Policy or Service Contract

1. Click the **Add Existing** button.
2. In **Select Elements** dialog, select Service Policies or Service Contract. The filled row is added in table.
