
Requirements numbering

When you create Requirements they are numbered by default with their unique IDs. The default Requirement IDs in the modeling tool are hierarchical numbers: 1, 1.1, 1.1.1, etc. See the following figure.

The special validation rules ensure that each Requirement ID in your project is unique. For example, it is valuable when working with Teamwork Server or T eamwork Cloud and Requirements appear with the same IDs after commits. The validation rules check that and show errors.

If you want a different Requirement numbering than the default, you can customize it manually by using the **Element Numbering** dialog. However, it is not recommended.
