
Creating a datatype property

To model a datatype property as a class attribute

- 1. Create a class, name it Class 1.
- 2. Click on the black circle with the white plus sign in the center of it.




3. Select Property.



4. A default property appears in the class. The property is also called a class attribute.



5. Double - click on the default property. Its **Specification window** appears.



- 6. Click on the Type field. A shortcut menu appears. Select boolean. (or any datatype property you want)
- 7. Click Close.

The result should look like this:
