Stop using 3DEXPERIENCE project in your project

If you no longer need to use a project, you can easily remove it from your project usages.

Removal is complete; all references to the elements stored in the used project will be eliminated.

Before you attempt to stop using a project, make sure other users are not currently creating usages to this project.

To stop using a project in your project

- Lock the used project you want to stop using.
 On the main menu, click Collaborate > Project Usages > Project Usages.
- 3. Select the used project and click the \square button.
