
Customizing AutoStyler

To access the customization page for AutoStyler


- 1. Click on Options > Project.
- 2. Click on Defined Elsewhere. Here you can customize AutoStyler.




Defined Elsewhere Page

To automatically apply customizations

1. Once you have adjusted your customizations, find the word $\mbox{\bf Apply}$ and click on it.



2. Make sure to select the correct diagram you would like to apply your customizations to.



3. After you select your diagram and click **OK** you will be led to another page where you will also click **OK**. You have now automatically applied all the customizations you wanted to make to all the classes.
