

# Displaying and hiding IRI

The IRIs of classes and properties may not be visible in the diagram pane. You can display them by using the shortcut menu **Display IRI**. To hide the IRIs from the diagram pane, you can select the shortcut menu **Hide IRI**.



## Newly create IRI tagged values

Newly created IRI tagged values are hidden in diagrams.

To display or hide the IRI tagged value of a class or an association end in the diagram pane

1. Right-click on a class or an association end in the diagram pane.
2. Select **Concept Modeling**, and select either **Display IRI** or **Hide IRI**.

To display or hide the IRI tagged values of all classes or association ends in the diagram pane

1. On the main menu, click **Edit > Select All**. All of the elements in the diagram pane will be selected.
2. Right-click on any element.
3. Select **Concept Modeling**, and select either **Display IRI** or **Hide IRI**.



## Note

- The menu **Display IRI** will appear when you right-click on an element whose IRI is hidden from the diagram pane.
- The menu **Hide IRI** will appear when you right-click on an element whose IRI is displayed in the diagram pane.
