Automatic Instantiation wizard


The **Automatic Instantiation** wizard is used to automatically instantiate any typical structure of UPDM architecture.

To open the Automatic Instantiation wizard

- 1. Select any number of instantiable UPDM elements and right-click them.
- 2. On the shortcut menu, choose **Tools** > **Create Instance**. The **Automatic Instantiation** wizard opens.

The wizard consists of these three steps:


1. Selecting parts.



In this step, select elements and their internal parts to instantiate. 2. Selecting a package.
