

# Creating SV-6 table

You can add [new](#) or [existing](#) Resource Interactions to fill in an SV-6 table.

To add new Resource Interaction

---

1. In the SV-6 diagram toolbar, click the **Add New** button. The [Realized Resource Interaction wizard](#) opens.
2. Follow the steps of the wizard.
3. Click **Finish** when you are done.  
The rows with created Resource Interactions are added to the table.

To add an existing Resource Interaction

---

1. In the SV-6 diagram toolbar, click the **Add Existing** button. The **Select Resource Interaction** dialog opens.
2. Select Resource Interactions by clicking **+** button.
3. Click **OK** when you are done.  
The rows with selected Resource Interactions are added to the table.



- Resource Interaction Identifier, Resource Interaction Item Name, Producing and Consuming Functions, and wide range of measurement cells are allowed to edit in the table.
- Sending Resource, Receiving Resource, and Implements cells are read only.
- You may use an [SV-1](#) view to create or modify a Resource Interaction.
- You can use [Resource Interaction Manager dialog](#) that enables to analyze and manage the Resource Interaction data.
