No Magic uses the FlexNet server ([the floating license server](#)) from [Flexera](#) for managing floating licenses.

A floating license allows you to install and use the same license (for example, [MagicDraw Standard](#), [Professional](#), [Enterprise Edition](#) or Plugins) on multiple machines. The licenses are managed by the floating license server. The floating license server knows how many floating licenses of the products and editions you have (for example, 2 Standard editions of MagicDraw and 3 Architect editions of Cameo Systems Modeler), and how many of these licenses are currently in use.

To use the FlexNet server:
