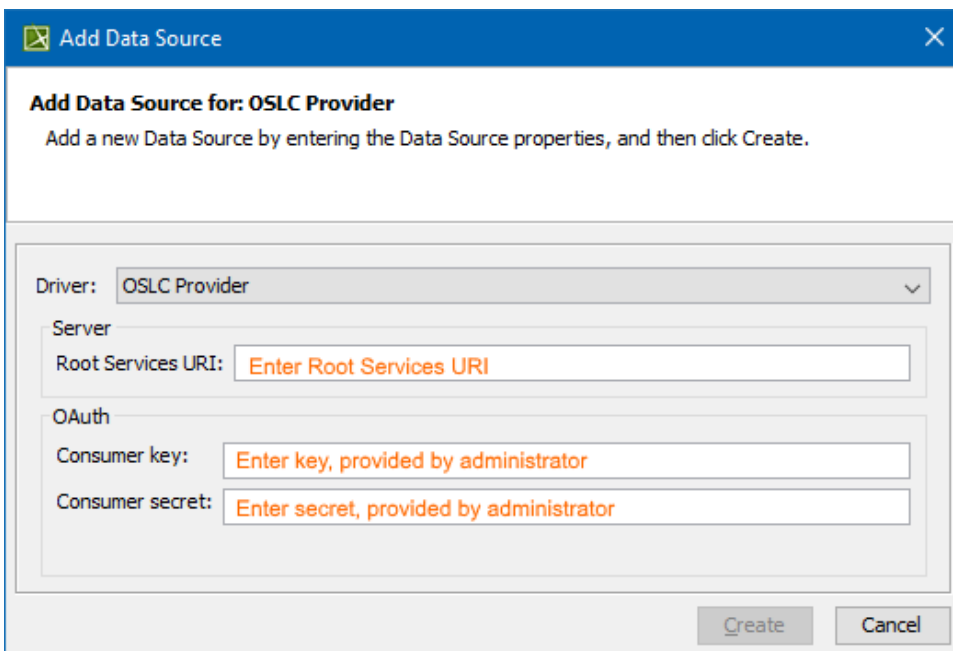


Adding Data Sources for an OSLC Provider

To add a Data Source for an OSLC Provider

1. Click  on the **DataHub Explorer** toolbar. The **Add Data Source** dialog opens.
2. From the **Driver** drop-down list, select **OSLC Provider**.
