


Creating a glossary table

In a concept model, a glossary table contains the names and descriptions of classes, association ends, attributes, enumerations, and enumeration literals that are defined in the concept model.

To create a glossary table

- 1. Right-click on the owning package.

**Note**

The owning package must have the correct «Model» or «Concept Model» stereotype for these menus to appear.

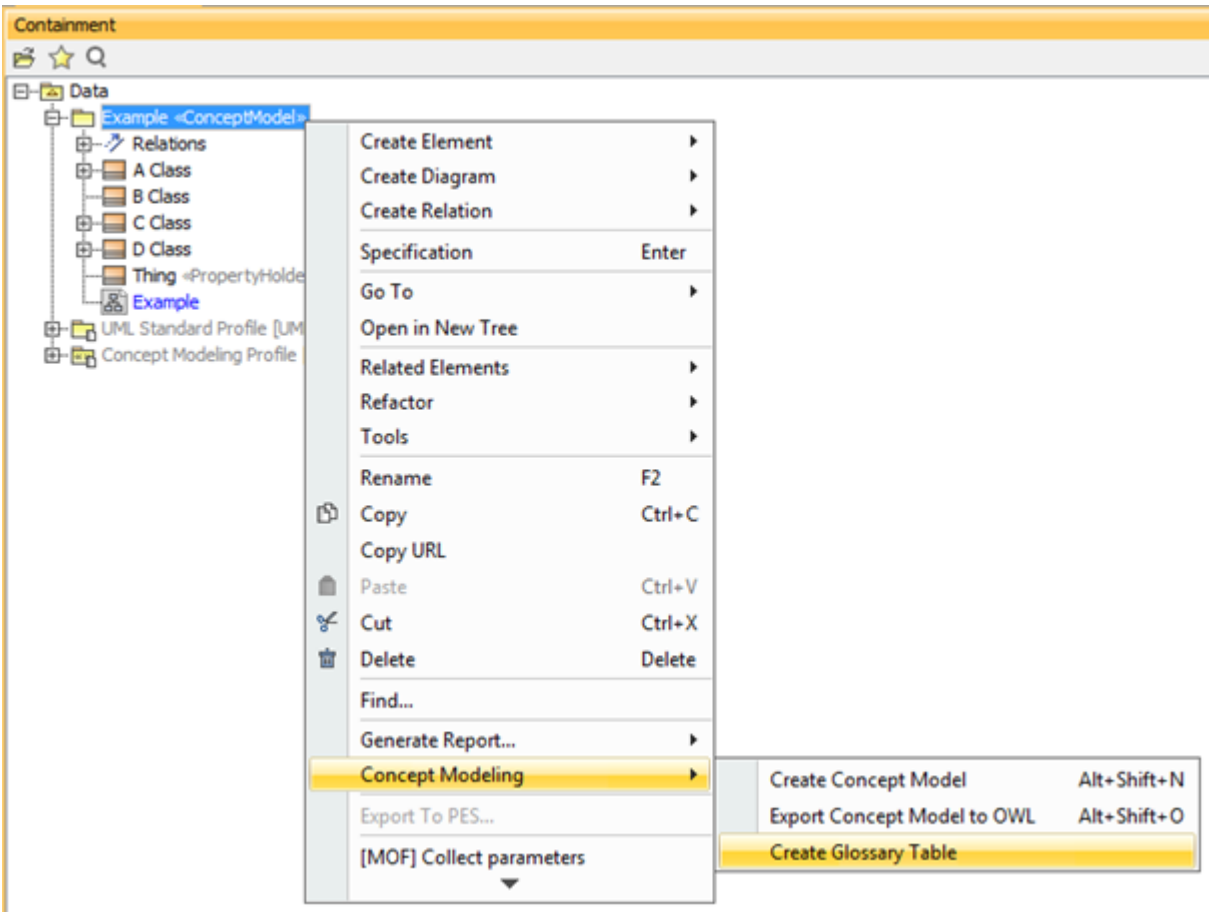


Figure 1: The Concept Modeler's Create Glossary Table menu.

- 2. Select **Concept Modeling > Create Glossary Table** (see Figure 1 below).

**Note**

If a glossary table already exists in the owning package, the **Create Glossary Table** menu option will not be available.

At least one glossary generation project option must be enabled. If all of the options are turned off, the **Create Glossary Table** menu option will be disabled.
