

Using TWAdmin

The objective of this section is twofold: to help you understand how the Teamwork Cloud Admin (TWAdmin) works and to provide detailed instructions for using the TWAdmin.

TWAdmin is a web interface that allows you to work with Teamwork Cloud (TWCloud) effectively. The web interface of TWAdmin is accessible through a web browser. It provides you with access to the TWCloud application and content. With TWAdmin, you can visually [manage users](#), [roles](#), and [resource assignments](#). The layout of the web interface or TWAdmin is designed for simplicity so that it is easy to understand and use.

The following sections describe the system security and access control to allow and restrict access to resources on the TWCloud system, and step-by-step instructions on how to use TWAdmin to work with projects and manage users who access the admin to accomplish tasks assigned to them.
