

Working with Typical Measurements table

To create Typical Measurements table

1. Do one of the following:
 - Click the **Add New** button and from the drop-down list select Property Set. The new row in the table is created. Type a name of the Property Set and specify the Measurements of the selected Property Set.
 - Click the **Add Existing** button to add an existing Property Set in the table.
2. Click the **Evaluate Measurements** button to created the Actual Measurements table automatically.

In the Typical Measurements table, you can select one of the Display Modes:

- **Owned Measurements** - collects only owned measurements.
- **All Measurements** - collects hierarchically all measurements with primitive types.
