

# Strategic Connectivity

## Description

The Strategic Connectivity (St-Cn) diagram depicts relationships between capabilities in which one capability cannot succeed without some form of assistance from another capability. The groupings of capabilities are logical, and the purpose of the groupings is to guide enterprise management. In particular, the dependencies and groupings may suggest specific interactions between acquisition projects to achieve the overall capability.

The intended usage of the Strategic Connectivity (St-Cn) includes:

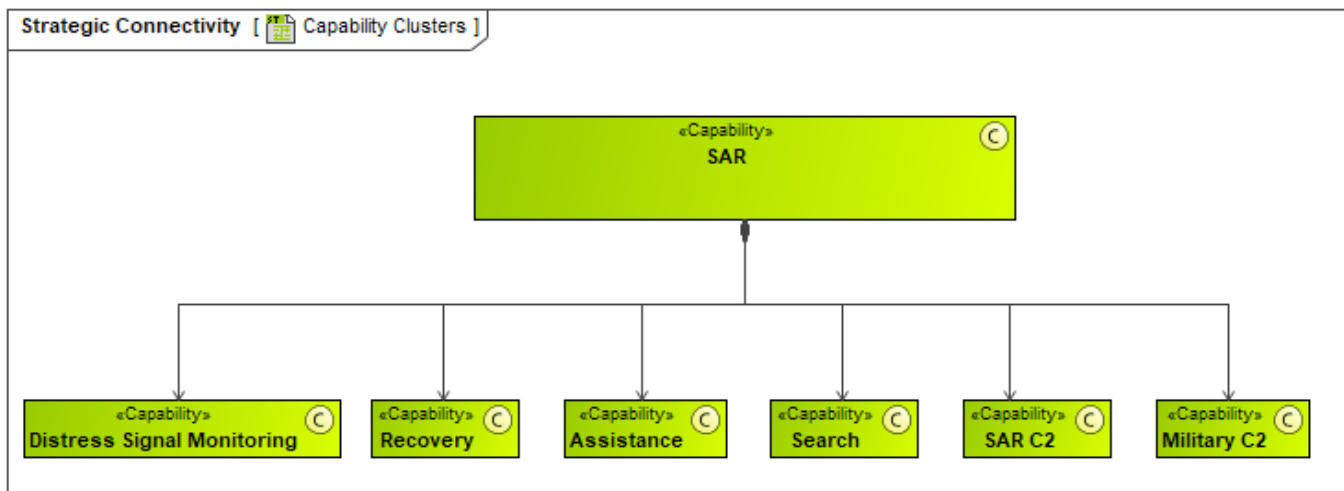
- Identification of capability dependencies.
- Capability management (impact analysis for options, disposal etc.).
