Description

The Personnel States (Pr-St) domain captures state-based behavior of an organizational resource. It is a graphical representation of states of an organizational resource and how that organizational resource responds to various events and actions.

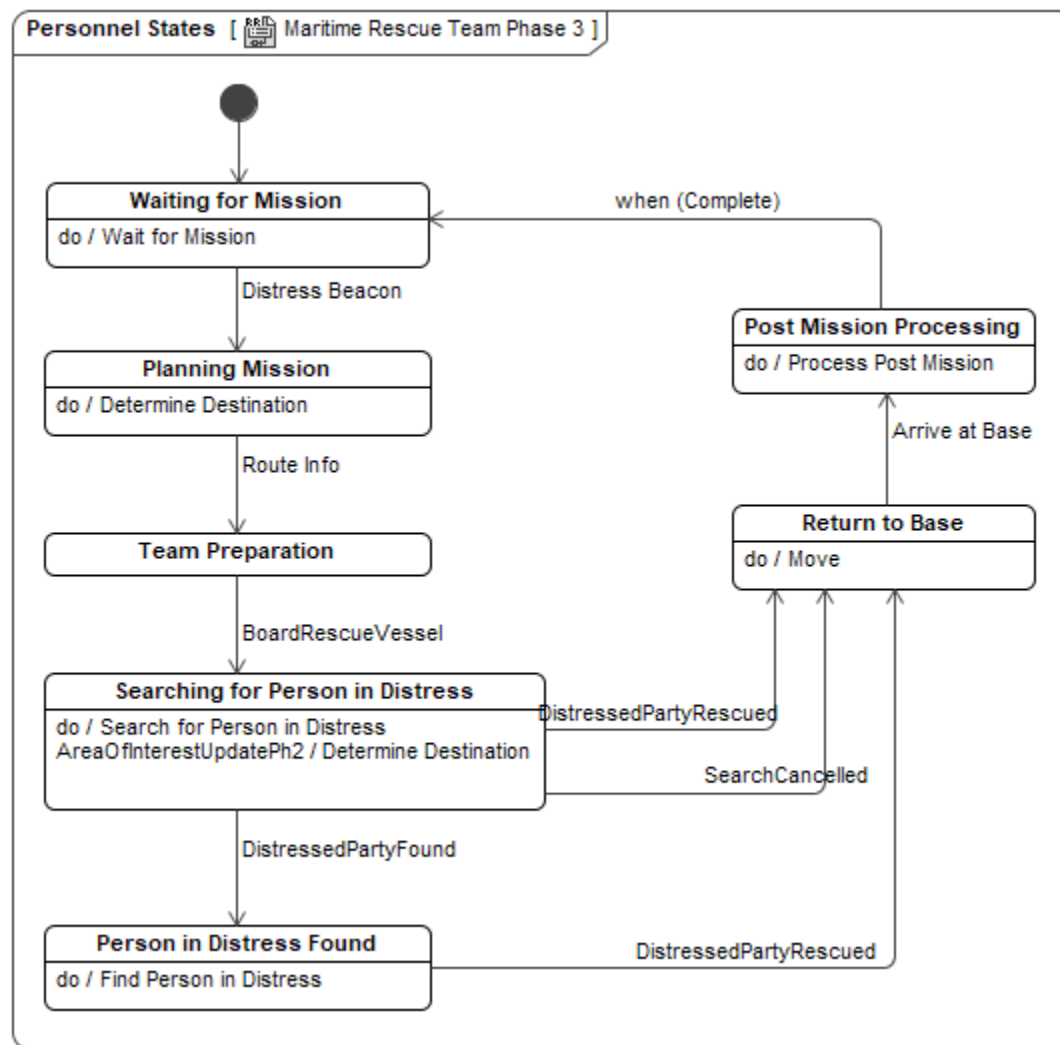
The intended usage of the Personnel States (Pr-St) domain includes:

- Definition of states, events and state transitions (behavioral modeling).
- Identification of constraints.
