

Exporting projects as templates

You can save (or export) the created project as a template and then use the same project for creating new projects.



This functionality is available in Standard, Professional, Architect, and Enterprise editions.

To export a project as a template

1. Open the project you want to export as a template.
2. From the **File** menu, select **Export To > Template**. The **Export Template** dialog opens.
3. Type the name and the description of the template.
4. Click **OK**. The project is exported as template.



- According to the template name in the **Export Template** dialog, the *.mdzip* file will be created in *<MagicDraw installation folder>\templates*. For example, type the name *LibraryTemplate* to save file as *LibraryTemplate.mdzip*.
- As of MagicDraw 17.0.3, when creating a new project from template, you can clone the custom used projects that exist in the template. Read more in [Creating new projects from templates](#).
