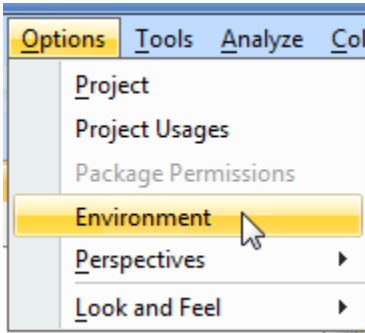


Selecting a default macro language

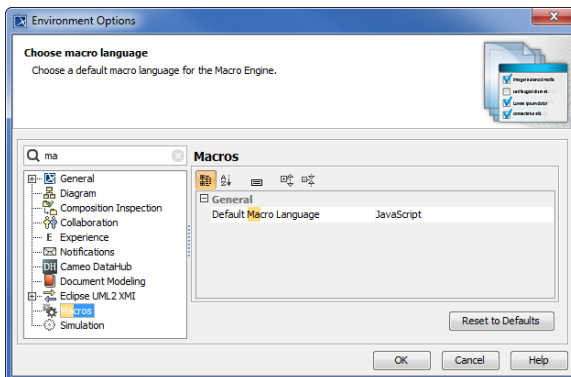
Use the **Environment Options** dialog to select a default macro language.

To select a default macro language

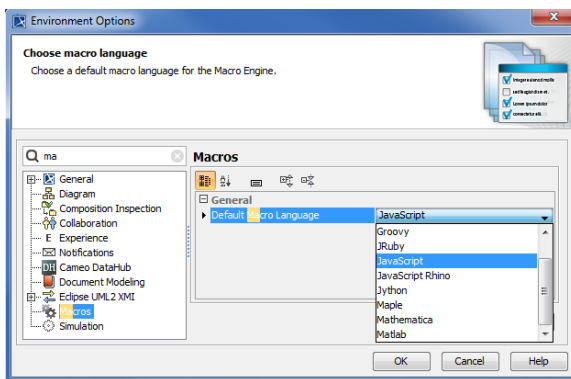
1. Click **Options > Environment** on the main menu.



The **Environment Options** dialog opens.



2. Select the **Macros** node.
3. Click the box next to the **Default Macro Language** box to see a list of supported programming languages, see figure below.



4. Select **Jython**, **BeanShell**, **Groovy**, **JRuby**, or **JavaScript**.
5. Click **OK** to save the selected language as the default macro language.



- JavaScript is the default macro language.
- Macro Engine currently supports BeanShell, Groovy, JRuby, JavaScript (Nashorn and Rhino), and Jython only.
