

# Rehosting commercial license


Rehosting is necessary, when you need to re-install Cameo Collaborator on another machine.

Rehosting includes the following steps:

1. License deactivation from the machine, where Cameo Collaborator is currently installed.
2. Installation of Cameo Collaborator on another machine.
3. [License activation](#) on the machine with the newly installed Cameo Collaborator.


To deactivate a commercial license

1. Log on to Cameo Collaborator as administrator.
2. In the address bar of the Internet browser, type `<server address>/alfresco/service/nm/activationRehost` and press Enter.


3. Copy the license deactivation ID (underlined string in the following figure) from the open webpage.

4. Log in at [www.nomagic.com](http://www.nomagic.com) as license owner.



Our license owner account is the one on which you have purchased the commercial license.

5. At the right side of the webpage, under **Members**, click **License Activation Management**. The **License Activation Management** page opens.
6. Paste the license deactivation ID into the **Enter License Deactivation ID to free slot** box.
7. Click **Submit**.

Your commercial license is deactivated. Now you can install Cameo Collaborator on another machine and [activate the commercial license](#) there.
