





Working with Operational Constraints table

To create an Operational Constraints table by adding a new Operational Constraint

1. Click the **Add New** button. The new row is added.
2. In the **Applies To** cell, click  and in the **Select Subject Of Operational Constraint** dialog, select constrained Operational Elements (Operational Performer, Operational Activity, Information Element, Operational Exchange).
3. In the **Rule Specification** cell, click  and in the **Specification** dialog, select the language and specify body.

 The Rule Specification can be defined in English as well as using expressions or formulas.

4. Select the **Rule Kind** from one of the following:
 - Structural Assertion
 - Action Assertion
 - Derivation
 - Contract
 - Constraint
 - Guidance
 - Security Policy
 - Caveat

 You can assign more than one Operational Constraint for one constraint.

To create an Operational Constraints table by adding a new Operational Constraint

1. Click the **Add Existing** button.
2. In **Select Operational Constraint** dialog, select Operational Constraints. The filled row is added in table.
