

Editing logical values

Logical (boolean) type property value can be either *true* or *false*. Examples of logical type properties: */s Abstract*, *Is Read Only*.

To edit a logical property value, do one of the following

- Select the check box to set the value to *true*.
- Clear the check box selection to set value to *false*.
