

# Creating custom model templates

The appearance and content of a published project can be customized by applying a custom template. In custom templates, you can specify which model elements are published, what element information is displayed, and the format in which it is displayed. A custom template can be stored within a model itself or as a separate .mdzip file, which allows you to reuse it multiple models. There are two main steps required to create a custom project template:
