

# Projects Structure

## Description

The Projects Structure (Pj-Sr) domain shows relationships between types of projects and project milestones. It provides a template for an actual project(s) road map(s) to be implemented. The Projects Structure (Pj-Sr) domain represents an organizational perspective on programs, projects, portfolios, or initiatives. The Projects Structure (Pj-Sr) domain enables the user to model the organizational structures needed to manage programs, projects, portfolios, or initiatives. It shows dependency relationships between the actual organizations that own the programs, projects, portfolios, or initiatives. This model could be used to represent organizational relationships associated with transformation initiatives along with those who are responsible for managing programs, projects, and portfolios. The Projects Structure (Pj-Sr) domain provides a means of analyzing the main dependencies between acquisition elements or transformation elements.


The intended usage of the Projects Structure (Pj-Sr) domain includes, but is not limited to:
