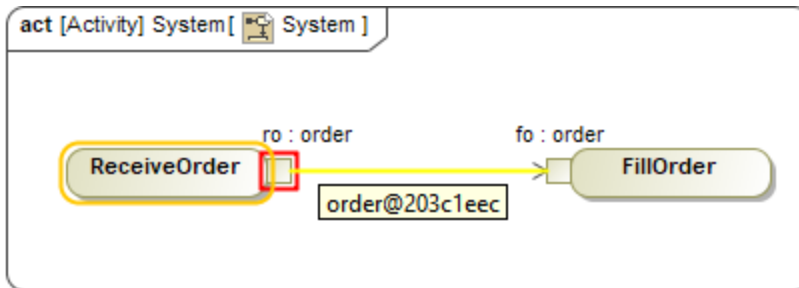


Dummy tokens of Actions through Output Pins

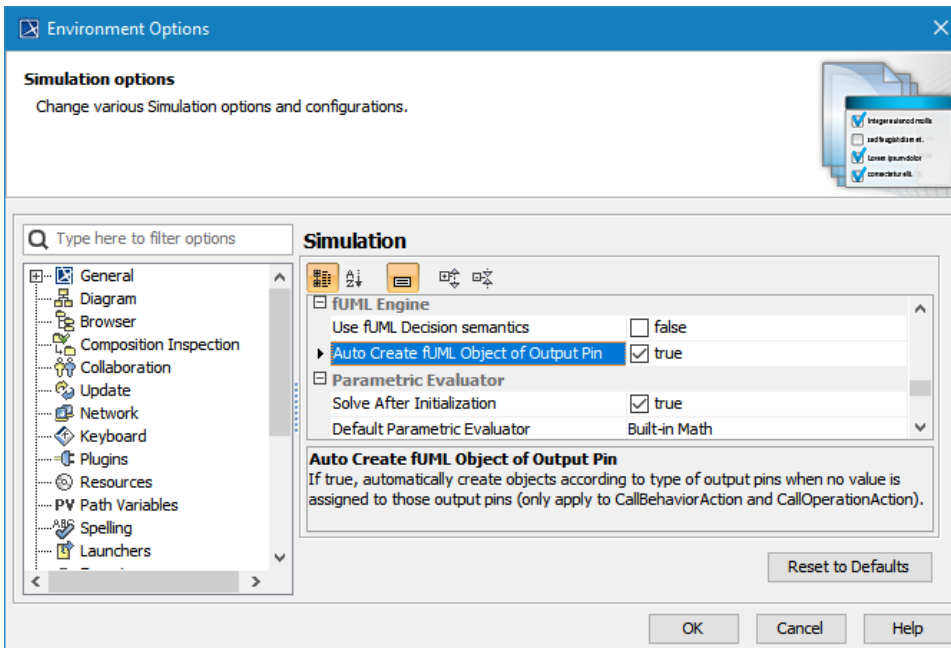
Simulation Toolkit has an option to support dummy tokens of Actions through Output Pins, which are breaks of fUML semantics. Business-level abstract diagrams can be executed and animated, since Simulation will automatically create new objects according to type of those Output Pins, if unspecified, or nothing is assigned to Output Pins. You can set the **Auto Create fUML Object of Output Pin** option, true by default, in the **Environment Options Simulation** dialog.



Objects are automatically created according to type of unspecified Output Pins, e.g., *order*.

To set the **Auto Create fUML Object of Output Pin** option

1. From the main menu, click **Options > Environment**. The **Environment Options** dialog opens.
2. On the left pane, click **Simulation**.
3. Under the **fUML Engine** group, set the **Auto Create fUML Object of Output Pin** option to **true**.
4. Select **OK**.
