

Using Eclipse to develop Groovy scripts

Use the following three simple steps to develop and run a Groovy script in NetBeans:

1. Install Groovy-Eclipse Plugin.
2. Develop a Groovy script.

To install Groovy-Eclipse Plugin

1. Go to <https://github.com/groovy/groovy-eclipse>.
2. Follow the instructions for installing Groovy-Eclipse Plugin.

To develop a Groovy Script

1. Create a Groovy project.
2. Right-click the project in Package Explorer and click **Properties**.
3. Click Java Build Path in the tree on the left-hand side. Click the **Libraries** tab on the right pane.
4. Click **Add External JARs** to add all the JAR files in *<modeling tool name>/lib* and in *<modeling tool name>/plugins/com.nomagic.magicdraw.automaton/engines/groovy-2.0.1/embeddable/groovy-all-2.0.1.jar*.
5. Click **OK** to close the dialog.
6. Create a new Groovy class in the project. Remove a class declaration, and then put the script there.
