

Deactivate license

License deactivation is the process of returning an activated license to the license pool. Deactivation is needed when installing a new version, moving the license to another workstation, or upgrading your operating system.

License deactivation

Prerequisites

- You have the [license owner](#) account credentials.

Procedure

- Log in at [nomagic.com](#) as a license owner.
- At the right side of the webpage, under **Members**, click **License Activation Management**.
- In the first table, all your activated products are listed. In the **Activated products** column, select a particular tool record for editing.

Create New License Activation Record

- A new **Edit License Activation Record** window opens. Click the **Deactivate** tab.
- Select the license you need and click **Deactivate selected**.
- Your license is deactivated and the allowed rehost number decreased. Close or refresh the **License Activation Management** page.



Increase the rehost limit, enter the request in the **Request Rehost Increase** box. Your account executive will restore rehosts after receiving this message.

Rehost limit is exceeded? Request increase from your account executive.

Request Rehost Increase

*Confirmed rehost case from the application side, will not decrease rehost limit.

**Rehost is the process of reissuing a license for a different machine. This process requires redefining existing node locked application license rights so that they will work properly on the new system. Number of available rehosts is 1 x for each obtained license per year.
