Password-protected projects

You can protect your server projects with a password. The password covers all project versions, and can be set or removed by a project owner or a user having Administer Resourcess permission.

You must be logged to a server to set a password for a particular project.

To set a password for a project

- 1. On the main menu, click Collaborate > Projects. The Manage Projects dialog opens.
- 2. In the Online project tab, select a project, you want to protect by a password and do one of the following:
 On the dialog toolbar, click the Set Password button.

 - Right-click the selected project and click Set Password.
