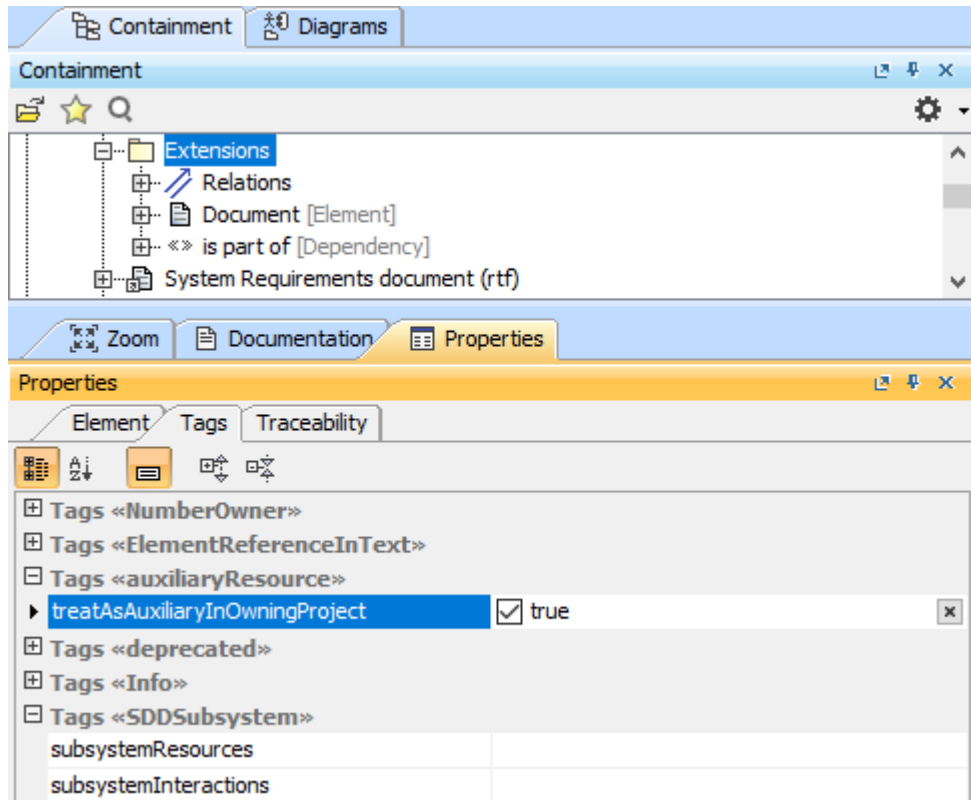


Marking elements as auxiliary

An auxiliary element is as element needed in the model but not necessary to be visible in the [Model Browser](#). Usually some profiles are marked as auxiliary and are not displayed by default in the model. You can mark the element in your model as an auxiliary as well.

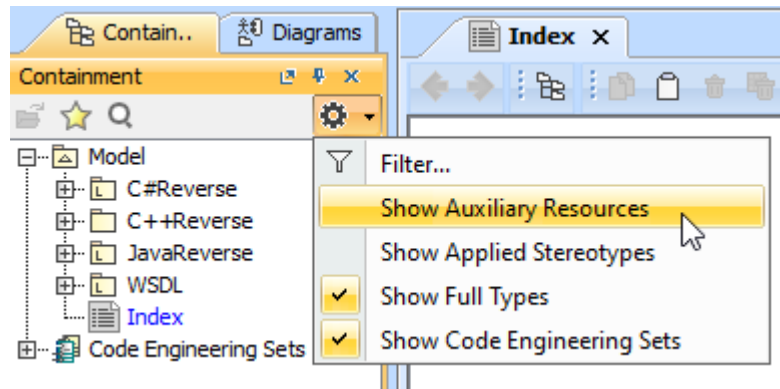
To mark an element as auxiliary

1. Select the element in the Model Browser.
2. In the **Properties** tab, select the **Tags** tab.
3. Set the **treatAsAuxiliaryInOwningProject** tag value to **true**.

The element marked as auxiliary is visible in the Model Browser in an option **Show Auxiliary Resources** is selected in the Options.



The Options drop-down list.

You can specify all auxiliary resources are shown in the model by default by specifying the [Environment Options](#) of your tool.

To show auxiliary resources by default in your model

1. On the main menu, click **Options > Environment**.
2. In the search box, type *auxiliary*. All auxiliary resources related properties appears in the options list.
3. Set the **Show Auxiliary Resources** property value to *true*.
