

Creating new elements

You can create a new element directly in the element selection dialog. To create a new element, turn on the element creation mode. The Tree view is opened automatically, when the element creation mode is turned on.

To turn on the element creation mode in the element selection dialog, do one of the following

- Click the **Creation Mode** button.
- In the **Tree** tab, right-click the empty space near the model tree and from the shortcut menu, select **Creation Mode**.

To create a new element in the element selection dialog

1. In the **Tree** tab, turn the element creation mode on.
2. In the model tree, select the owner for a new element and do one of the following:
 - Click the **Create** button.
 - Right-click the selected element or empty space near the model tree and from the shortcut menu, select **Create**.
3. In the list of available elements, select the element you want to create.
4. The [Specification window](#) of a new element opens. Specify desired element properties and click **Close**.
