

Converting Certificates to JKS Format

Teamwork Server recognizes certificates stored in *Java KeyStore (JKS)* format. If certificates are in *PEM* format, they must be converted to *JKS* format. You can use OpenSSL (<http://www.openssl.org/>) and *Sun Java KeyTool* (included with every Java distribution) for this purpose. For example, if we have a certificate in a file called *cert.pem*, then the following commands will convert it to *JKS* format:

```
openssl x509 -in cert.pem -out cert.der -outform der
```

```
keytool -importcert -alias mycert -file cert.der -keystore truststore.jks
```
