# **Uninstalling plugin**

To uninstall a plugin

- 1. Start the modeling tool.
- 2. In the Help menu, select Resource/Plugin Manager.
- 3. In the Resource/Plugin Manager dialog, click to select the plugin.
- 4. Click the Remove button.
- 5. When you receive the message asking if you want to remove the plugin, click OK.
- 6. Restart the modeling tool.

## **Deactivating license**

### Prerequisites

· You have the license owner account credentials.

#### Procedure

- 1. Log in at nomagic.com as a license owner.
- 2. At the right side of the webpage, under Members, click License Activation Management.
- 3. In the first table, all your activated products are listed. In the Activated products column, select the tool record to edit.

- 4. A new Edit License Activation Record window opens. Click the Deactivate tab.
- 5. Select the license you need and click **Deactivate selected**.
- 6. Your license is deactivated and the allowed rehost number decreased. Close or refresh the License Activation Management page.

\*\*Rehost is the process of reissuing a license for a different machine. This process requires redefining existing node locked application license rights so that they will work properly on the new system. Number of available rehosts is 1 x for each obtained license per year.
