

# Uninstalling plugins and deactivating licenses

## Uninstalling plugin

To uninstall a plugin

1. Start the modeling tool.
2. In the **Help** menu, select **Resource/Plugin Manager**.
3. In the **Resource/Plugin Manager** dialog, click to select the plugin.
4. Click the **Remove** button.
5. When you receive the message asking if you want to remove the plugin, click **OK**.
6. Restart the modeling tool.

## Deactivating license

### Prerequisites

- You have the [license owner account credentials](#).

### Procedure

1. Log in at [nomagic.com](#) as a license owner.
2. At the right side of the webpage, under **Members**, click **License Activation Management**.
3. In the first table, all your activated products are listed. In the **Activated products** column, select the tool record to edit.

6. Your license is deactivated and the allowed rehost number decreased. Close or refresh the **License Activation Management** page.

\*Confirmed rehost case from the application side, will not decrease rehost limit.

\*\*Rehost is the process of reissuing a license for a different machine. This process requires redefining existing node locked application license rights so that they will work properly on the new system. Number of available rehosts is 1 x for each obtained license per year.
