

# Getting started

The Cameo Requirement Modeler Plugin implements the requirements part of the OMG SysML standard that is widely used in the system engineering. All concepts and modeling approaches that are used in requirement modeling with the plugin are from the requirement part of the SysML standard which can be found at <http://www.omgsysml.org>. The SysML requirement part provides clear essential means for the model-based requirements management independently from the system engineering domain, so it could be easily adopted for all other domains as software, business, and enterprise.
