Checking if the FlexNet server is running

There are three ways to check if the FlexNet server is running:

- Log on to the FlexNet Manager Web Interface. The default address is http://localhost:8090 or use your server name (http://server name (<a href="http://server name
- 2. Check the Imadmin task status in:
 - Task Manager on Windows
 - Activity Monitor on OS X
 - System Monitor on Linux

If the status is *Running*, the FlexNet server is running.

3. Open the *Imadmin.log* file which can be found in <*Imadmin installation directory*>*Vogs*. Lines in the following example identify that *Imadmin* is successfully started and the FlexNet server is running:

```
2015-12-09 20:28:31,781 root.LicenseEngine started without redundancy.

2015-12-09 20:28:31,958 root.Vendor (cameo) started.

2015-12-09 20:28:31,778 root Version: 11.13.1.0 build 166859 (2015.06.16-10.40.53)
```

If the FlexNet server is not running, open the *Imadmin.log* file, found in <*Imadmin installation directory*>*Vogs*. The installation error codes are listed there. Use the error codes to try to find a solution in the FlexNet server License Administration Guide:
