Selecting multiple property values

In this case you can assign more than one value to a property in the **Select Element** dialog. Examples of properties that may have multiple values: *Classifi* er, *Method*.

To assign multiple property values

- 1. Click an appropriate property value cell.
- 2. Click the Edit button (see the highlighted button in the following figure). The Select Element dialog opens.
- 3. Select existing and / or create elements.
- 4. Click OK when you are done.

Make sure the Multiple Selection mode is turned on.
