

Creating new values

In Cameo Collaborator for Teamwork Cloud, you can create values for stereotype tags and textual properties right in a Cameo Collaborator document. This will simplify your workflow because you will no longer need a modeling tool or any workarounds to add new values to your model.

Text	Regenerative braking is an energy recovery mechanism that slows down a moving vehicle or object by converting its kinetic energy into a form that can be either used immediately or stored until needed.

Documentation	In this mechanism, the electric traction motor uses the vehicle's momentum to recover energy that would otherwise be lost to the brake discs as heat. This contrasts with conventional braking systems, where the excess kinetic energy is converted to unwanted and wasted heat due to friction in the brakes, or with dynamic brakes, where the energy is recovered by using electric motors as generators but is immediately dissipated as heat in resistors.
