Forward compatibility

The cross-version compatibility checking mechanism is implemented when a project with new feature usages is loaded with an older version of the modeling tool. Currently, the cross-version compatibility checking mechanism tracks feature usages of 19.0 SP1,19.0 SP2, and later service pack versions that result in triggering **Missing features detected** notification in earlier versions. The following table shows tracked features, the version they appear in, and whether the project can be committed/saved without any consequences.

Important

Features required, but missing, in an earlier tool version (for example, 19.0) are memorized by the cross-version compatibility checking mechanism. This process will continue with each SP release (i.e., SP2 might have features that are missing in both SP1 and 19.0 GA).
