

Signing in to TWCloud Admin


To sign in to TWCloud Admin

1. In an internet browser, go to http(s)://<machine ip>:<port>/webapp. For example, if the machine IP is 10.1.1.123 and the default port is used, the URL will be https://10.1.1.123:8443/webapp.




2. When the authentication page opens, enter your username and password to sign in.





After you sign in you will be directed to the main Web Application Platform page (https://10.1.1.123:8443/webapp)

Once you are logged in, you will be redirected to the landing page depending on your role/ permissions. To navigate in the TWCloud Admin environment use the app bar. Depending on their roles and permissions, some users may not be able to access some specific content in the TWCloud system or view the detail.

• In the top right corner click button and select **Sign out** to sign out of the current user account.
