

Working with model elements in the Model Browser

In the Model Browser, you can do the various actions with model elements, such as rename, cut, copy, delete, and others. These actions are available from the particular model element shortcut menu. See the list of concrete actions in the following table.

Command	Function
Rename	Switches the element name into the edit mode. You can also press F2 for this.
Copy	Copies the selected element.
Copy URL	Copies a model element URL to a clipboard.
Copy Element Hyperlink	Copies the hyperlink of the selected element.
Cut	Cuts the selected element.
Paste	Pastes the copied element.
Delete	Deletes the selected element.

To copy/cut and paste the selected model element between different projects

1. Select the model element in the Model Browser.
2. From the model element shortcut menu, select **Copy** or **Cut**.
3. Open the project to which you want to paste the selected element(s).
4. Select the container, where you wish to paste the element(s).
5. From the container's shortcut menu, select **Paste**.

To change the location of an element in the Model Browser

1. Select the element in the Model Browser.
2. Drag it to the new location (possible owner).
