

Forward compatibility

The cross-version compatibility checking mechanism is implemented when a project with new feature usages is loaded with an older version of the modeling tool. Currently, the cross-version compatibility checking mechanism tracks feature usages of 2022x Refresh1 and later Refresh versions that result in triggering **Missing features detected** notification in earlier versions. The following table shows tracked features, the version they appear in, and whether the project can be committed/saved without any consequences.

Feature name	Version	Secure to commit/save
Requirements verification in Instance Table	2022x Refresh1	Yes



Important

Features required but missing in an earlier tool version (for example, 2022x) are memorized by the cross-version compatibility checking mechanism. This process will continue with each Refresh release (i.e., 2022x Refresh2 might have features that are missing in both 2022x Refresh1 and 2022x).
