

How to change JVM version

To change JVM version

1. Go to *<modeling tool installation directory>\bin* and open the *<modeling tool>.properties* file (eg., *magicdraw.properties*, *esm.properties*, *cameoea.properties*) for editing. If you are using MagicDraw 17.0.4 or earlier, the name of the property file is *mduml.properties*.
2. In the JAVA_HOME line, add the path to the Java software. For example: `JAVA_HOME=C:\Program Files\Java\jre1.8.0_144`



Integrated MagicDraw runs on the JVM specified by the IDE. In order to change the JVM, you must modify the startup properties for the IDE that MagicDraw integrates with. If you are running MagicDraw integrated with IDE, read the appropriate readme.html for specific integration, found in the *integrations* folder.
